Registration – Electronic Information Services Responsible Use Agreement Policy 2012-2013

Core Beliefs

We believe that students should be able to use the technology they have at their own disposal to enhance their educational experience both inside and outside of the classroom. When appropriate, teachers and students as a proactive learning community should take advantage of these opportunities.

We believe students should be able to access the district's EIS (Wi-Fi, Internet, E-mail, etc.). Access to high speed Internet is essential for global learning and discovery.

We believe that students should be able to use various products to "show what they know". We should be able to use the new forms of technology available to complete schoolwork when our learning community decides it's appropriate.

We believe that teachers who implement technology into classrooms are critical to student success. Teachers are able to integrate technology and traditional teaching methods in the classroom and know that I need to be taught how to balance my life between the online and offline worlds.

We believe that students should acquire and practice 21st century skills through their learning in the Casa Grande Union High School District. This will ensure our preparedness for post-secondary education and our employability in the modern job market.

We believe that students should be taught how to be aware of and protect themselves and others from the dangers associated with technology. Students should be instructed in the tenets of digital citizenship and Internet safety.

We believe that teachers are masters of their trade. They are passionate about what they do and embrace the use of various tools, including the introduction of appropriate technologies to their subject areas to increase student achievement. These professionals attend trainings and practice. They value students' expertise in the changing world of technology.

We believe that students and teachers should not be bound by hardware and its storage limitations. They should be able to access their school-supported information anywhere.

Student Responsibilities

I am solely responsible for any property I bring to school including electronic devices. We acknowledge that the district is not responsible for the technology that students bring from home (ie. loss, damage, theft, etc.).

I have the responsibility to use the CGUHSD network (Electronic Information System, or EIS) for educational purposes only—school projects, lessons, or class related activities.

I have the responsibility to apply my technological skills and my own voice in order to present information in an innovative matter that fits the expected criteria and will add to my educational experience.

I have the responsibility to use only my assigned password to access the EIS. I will not share my password with other people and I will report any inappropriate EIS password use.

I have the responsibility to log off the EIS when I have finished using it to protect my own information and the district's.

I have the responsibility to use the computers and EIS appropriately at school. This includes not looking up material that contains violence, hate speech, profanity, sex, drugs or alcohol that are not directly related to educational activities. I also have the responsibility to report inappropriate use by others. If I enter an inappropriate site accidentally, I will tell an adult immediately.

I have the responsibility to use school email only to contact teachers. I understand that my email is not private and can be accessed by district personnel at any time.

I have the responsibility to use only my own work. I will not steal intellectual property from other people by plagiarizing or violating copyright rules.

I have the responsibility to check the quality of my online sources and cite those sources properly.

I have the responsibility to help prevent and report the act of Cyber bullying.

I have the responsibility to keep the network safe by not downloading or installing programs, music, or games via any media, unless they are used for educational purposes, determined by school personnel.

I have the responsibility to only purchase, trade, or request items on the Internet exclusively for related school projects.

I have the responsibility to protect my confidential or FERPA protected (<http://www.nacada.ksu.edu/Resources/FERPA-Overview.htm>) information (social security numbers, credit card numbers, addresses, etc.).

I have the responsibility not to circumvent or attempt to circumvent district security measures including, but not limited to; network security, web filters, virus protection, or any other security measures employed on district technology.
