List of Jobs and Times for Volunteers

We are getting down to the wire and need to confirm those of you who will be available to help this year with Arizona City Daze. We definitely want to avoid "any surprises". Below is the plan and needs for various location/task commitments. Here is the plan with both location and timing needs:

- FRIDAY, March 6, at 3 PM
 - Ken & Rich will be at AC Chamber Office (south end of building) on Sunland Gin Rd. to 1) haul materials to the Alsdorf Rd. AC Daze event site, & then 2) set up fencing, stage, tents. **Two to three flatbed trailers are needed and at least 10 to 15 volunteers.**

- SATURDAY, March 7
 - 5 AM to 11 AM - Ken and Rich - place barricades and signs, assign ROTC to street locations, line out parade, pickup barricades and signs after parade. **Needs: Ken & Rich are looking for 1 or 2 people with leadership ability to help this year and "learn the ropes" to eventually be organizers in the future!**

 - 5 AM – Team leaders Julie Ferguson and Peggy Devine at Alsdorf/Sunland Gin to assist Kimberly (vendor manager) in getting vendors properly parked on Alsdorf. **One or two golf carts would also be helpful! Need one or two additional volunteers.**

 - 7 AM – Team leaders Julie Ferguson and Peggy Devine - Stage area on Alsdorf for table & chair setup --**Need 8 to 10 volunteers for 1 hr.**

7 AM – Joanne Parsons, Mary Short, & Linda Zumwalt – managing sign in for parade entrants at Laredo & Concordia (no more help needed)

 - 5 PM - Alsdorf stage area to take down tents, tables, chairs, fencing etc. Team Leaders Ken & Rich—**Need 10 to 15 volunteers and two or three flatbed trailers**

Of course we want to make sure we have a good crew to accomplish the tasks at hand. Will look forward to your response of specifically what you can do this year. More details will follow once we know who can help out in 2020.
