

COVID-19 School Benchmarks

By Arizona County

The Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) recommends county-specific public health benchmarks fall within the **moderate** or **minimal** spread category in all three benchmarks for two weeks in order to provide Hybrid learning (virtual and in-person). The [ADHS Schools Toolkit](#) defines community spread levels and the delivery models outlined below.

School reopening plans should encompass four scenarios:

- Traditional/in-person - All students in physical buildings
- Hybrid - Some students in physical buildings and some students distance learning
- Virtual - All students distance learning with onsite support services
- Intermittent - Intermittent distance learning based on emergency closures as defined by state and local health departments
