

Early College Program

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Who do I contact if I have questions about Early College?

A: You can send an email to earlycollege@centralaz.edu or call the Central Arizona College Recruitment office at 520-494-5111. A staff member will answer your question(s) or you can leave a message and someone will call you back.

Q: Do I need to be attending a Pinal County public high school?

A: No, Early College students must only be a Pinal County resident.

Q: How are my Early College tuition funds applied?

A: Early College will cover 5 credits of tuition for any courses 100 level and above. Anything over 5 credits will be the student's responsibility. Tuition is \$86 per credit hour.

Q: What if I do not need Early College tuition this semester?

A: As an Early College student, you are eligible for Early College tuition funds, as needed, beginning the summer after your sophomore year until the summer after you graduate from high school. This is available to you as long as you maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA at CAC.

Q: Do I use one Early College form for each semester?

A: Yes, you will need to have one (1) Early College form completed and turned in with your registration form for each semester you want to take classes, including summer sessions.

Q: What are the requirements to be eligible for Early College?

A: The requirements are as follows:

- Complete the CAC Online Application
- Maintain a college grade point average of 2.5
- Meet each semester with an Academic Advisor
- Register for and attend a CAC Orientation

Q: Where do I send my completed application and registration form?

A: The completed **Early College Application** along with the **Registration Form** should be emailed **together** to admissions@centralaz.edu, **no later** than the registration deadline.
