SENIOR CLEARANCE

Tuesday, May 14, 2024, Senior Clearance cards pickup during lunches in the security office. ALL Seniors must have their clearance card signed by the Librarian, Bookstore Manager, and IT stating their accounts have been cleared.

Wednesday, May 15, 2024, Seniors will work to complete clearance cards. When complete, all cards will be given to Ms. Mendoza in B130.

Thursday, May 16, 2024, Clearance cards are due to Ms. Mendoza no later than 4:00 PM.

GRADUATION ELIGIBILITY VERIFICATION

Friday, May 17, 2024, 9:00 AM, Practice Gym, Seniors will pick up eligibility verification cards from their counselors. Seniors will need this card to participate in the graduation ceremony. To streamline this process, counselors will be in the practice gym.

We have scheduled practice sessions for the ceremony, so everyone will know the procedures. Attendance is <u>required</u> for BOTH graduation practices on the mornings of the 20th & 21st to have the honor of participating in the ceremony. Please plan to be outside the entire morning on both days. It's usually very hot, so bring water. Sunblock and hats are recommended.

TUESDAY, MAY 21, 2024

5:45 -6:15 - Senior Social in Gym.

6:30 PM - Graduates arrive at designated area.

7:30 PM – Graduation Ceremony - Al Van Hazel Football Stadium.

DRESS GUIDELINES FOR GRADUATION CEREMONY

- Students should arrive at school **no later than 6:30 PM, <u>CARRYING</u>** their cap and gown. Students should not put on their gown until after they have checked in with their line leader.
- Dress guidelines for all students; Graduation is a dignified event. Students should wear Semi/Formal attire. (For example: dresses, skirts, dress slacks, and dress shoes.) Stilettos are not allowed to be worn on the track; wedges are permitted.
- Any student who appears to be under the influence of a controlled substance will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony.

CEREMONY

Guests are asked to treat the ceremony with appropriate dignity. Balloons, outside food, and beverages are prohibited in the football stadium. Single unopened bottles of water will be allowed. The attention should be on the graduates and not on the people in the audience. Applause is appropriate, but common courtesy needs to be displayed so every graduate's name is heard. Noisemakers are both distracting and disrespectful. Spectators are expected to be seated in the bleachers throughout the ceremony. Guests may sit on either the East side (visitor's side) or West side (home side) of the bleachers. Check with your graduate after Tuesday morning's practice to determine on which side he/she will be sitting. Re-entry to the event will not be permitted under any circumstance.

*** The number of guests may be limited due to unforeseen circumstances such as weather.

Graduates must sign for and pick up their diplomas in the designated area immediately following the celebration.

GRADUATE PARKING – Transportation Facility (south of the school, off Trekell Road)

- We encourage Graduates to park at the Transportation Facility south of the school to allow their family and friends to park on school grounds. There will be a bus/golf carts to shuttle seniors to and from the gym.
- The Public may park in the school parking lots. Parking permits are not required. Once all the lots are full, you may park in the vicinity of the school grounds. Handicapped parking will be available on school grounds on a first-come, first-served basis. A handicap parking permit/license plate is required to park in those designated spaces. Shuttles will be available from handicapped parking spaces to the stands.
- We encourage parents and friends to carpool when possible.

GRAD IMAGES

To inform parents about graduation photos, Grad Images has developed a pre-registration system that allows graduates to provide email and mailing address information to Grad Images prior to the ceremony. INCLEMENT WEATHER

If inclement weather conditions warrant changing the ceremony, the event will be changed to **Friday**, **May 24**, **7:30 PM**. **All guidelines that are implemented above will remain in effect.**
