

# Chinese II Syllabus

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## Course Objectives:

This course is designed to introduce basic vocabulary used in school and in students' daily conversations. Students will learn to read and write simplified Chinese characters, as well as using them to construct simple dialogues. Various projects and activities will allow students the opportunities to explore Chinese culture, festivals, cooking, and calligraphy.

## Supplies

- Textbook & Workbook
- iPad
- Loose-leaf notebook paper
- Pen/pencil
- cards

## Upon completion, successful students will be able to do the following in Mandarin Chinese:

1. Know all kinds of transportations.
2. Know how to ask the road and answer.
3. Say some sports and ask what's your favorite sports.
4. Ask how about your weekend and answer.
5. Ask what you like, what you don't like.
6. Talk about musical instruments and types of music

## Classroom/Expectations:

1. Be on time and ready to learn.
2. Be prepared (have your book, workbook, pencil, & iPad.)
3. Complete your work on time and with pride.

4. Remain silent during instruction.
5. No back packs, cell phones, food & drinks (except water), off-task iPad use in class.

Consequences of breaking a rule:

1<sup>st</sup> Time - Verbal warning

2<sup>nd</sup> Time - Disciplined referral & parents called

3<sup>rd</sup> Time - Discipline referral & student sent to the administration

Homework Assignments:

Homework assignments are due at the beginning of class. Only completed homework will receive credit.

Quizzes and Tests:

There will be a quiz at the end of each Lesson. Tests will be given at the end of each unit. Projects are assigned periodically for students to demonstrate their learned skills. Students who are absent during a quiz or test need to be ready to make up the quiz or test on the day they return to school.

Any work turned in without a name will receive a ZERO.

Attendance:

Attendance will be taken every day at the beginning of class. Absences and tardiness are strongly discouraged. Students are responsible for catching up their missed classwork, homework and notes.
