



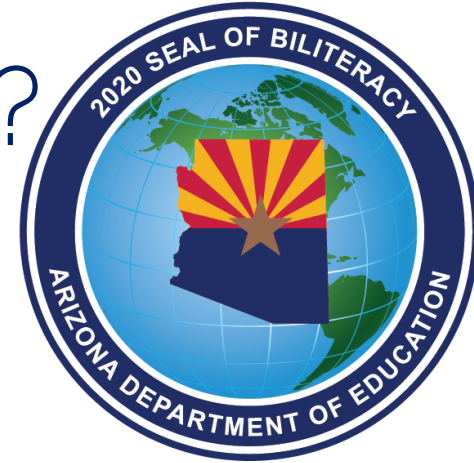

What is the Arizona Seal of Biliteracy?

SB 1239 – Law creating the seal of biliteracy



- CREATES A SEAL OF BILITERACY
- PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICTS OR PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOLS CHOOSE TO OPT IN AND RECORD DATA TO REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION
- STUDENT MUST DEMONSTRATE PROFICIENCY IN ONE OR MORE LANGUAGE IN ADDITION TO ENGLISH
- STUDENTS MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS GET A SEAL ATTACHED TO THEIR DIPLOMA AND A NOTATION ON THEIR TRANSCRIPT



English Requirements

- ❑ Successfully completes all English Language Arts Requirements – 4 credits

Approved English End-of-Course Exam Options:

- Statewide assessment
- Nationally recognized college entrance exam
- An exam accepted for credit or admission to on university under the jurisdiction of the Arizona Board of Regents
- End of course exam administered as part of a dual enrollment or concurrent enrollment course
- An exam that is accepted for credit or placement in a community college
- Advanced Placement exams

MAINTAIN A G.P.A. OF 2.0/4.0 IN THE ENGLISH COURSES

an end-of-course exam from approved menu of assessments.

English is student's second language, student needs to meet proficiency on the AZELLA test.



Second Language

Requirements



Students must demonstrate proficiency through an assessment approved by the State of Education.

REPORTING

- Intent to participate form – must be completed by November 1st
- **ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF PROFICIENCY FORM – MUST BE COMPLETED BY NOVEMBER 1ST**
- **FINAL REPORTING FORM MUST BY SUBMITTED 90 DAYS AFTER THE LAST DAY OF SCHOOL**
