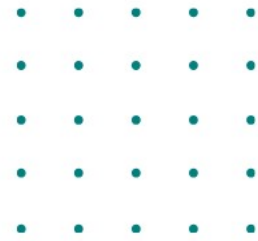

PACE *is not* an alternative or credit recovery school. We are a personalized mastery-based high school. Our students earn a standard high school diploma as required in the state of Arizona.

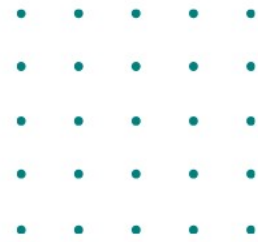

What does personalized and mastery-based mean?

It means that we tailor the learning tasks and instructional support to our students as individual people. *All students have a Personalized Learning Portfolio/Plan.* Students must demonstrate mastery of skills and competencies to move to the next level or learning portfolio.

Do you grade using traditional letters like A, B, C, D, F?

Our students are scored on their level of performance which ranges from a 2-12. The ultimate goal by the end of their high school experience is to be at a 10, which is college and career ready. These scores convert to traditional letter grades at the end of each semester. Our students can replace any failing grades in semester 1 with a better grade from semester 2.

What makes you different?

All of our students are connected to an advisor that acts as their “learning Sherpa” to guide them through their personal high school experience. Students have the ability to *accelerate their path to graduation* and entrance into the world of work. Our learning spaces *replicate a college student union* experience to allow for *creativity in thinking and flexibility in location* of learning and task completion.

Can students participate in sports and clubs?

Yes, our students *can participate in athletics* on Vista or Union's campus depending on where they live. We even provide transportation to practices.
