Entrance Flow of Traffic

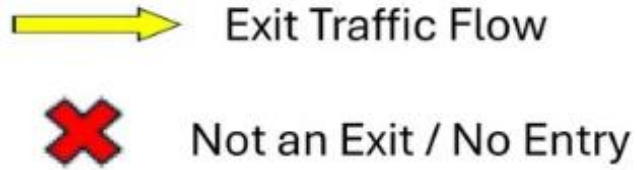


Parking Lot Flow

Vista Grande Graduation Ingress Parking Plan – Parking Lots A, B, and C





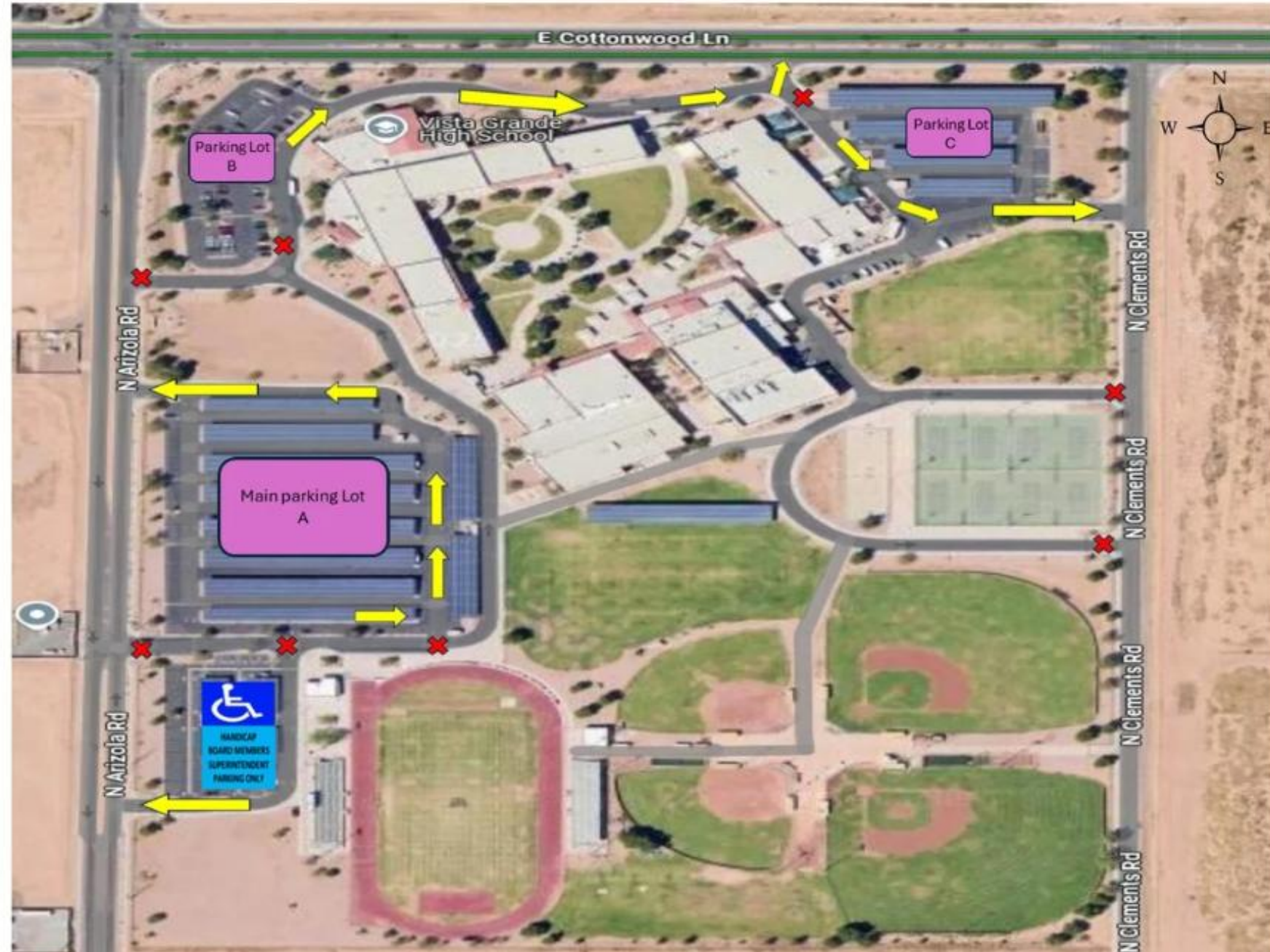
Marquee Gate will be closed after Graduation

GRADUATES

- They must be in the small gym by 6:45 PM with their Cap & Gown
- They may decorate their cap (school-appropriate) but should not alter their gown
- They should wear semi-formal attire. No tennis shoes, flip-flops, or shorts will be allowed.
- No money or candy leis until after the ceremony



TICKETS



- Each graduate will receive 8 tickets for guests.
- Tickets will be designated for either the home side, visitor side, or track area, depending on the graduate's assigned seating.
- All guests, including children of all ages, must have a ticket to attend.
- Students will receive their tickets on May 19th, after completing the clearance checkout process.
- Lost tickets will not be replaced, so please keep them in a safe place.
- Re-Entry is not permitted





CEREMONY

Inside the Stadium

- No balloons or ice chests
- Only clear bags/backpacks are allowed
- Diaper Bags are subject to search
- No smoking or vaping
- Snacks, soda, and water will be available at the concession boxes, cash only.
- We ask guests to not bring strollers in consideration of space constraints.

- All guests will be required to pass through weapons detection monitors upon entry
- Walkways (including stairs) need to be cleared at all times
- Guests must be seated at all times, unless using the restroom or getting concessions
- Guests cannot be lined up against the railings or fences
- There will be video screens, so everyone can see the celebration
