- If you are done with your daily assignment consider reviewing for any upcoming tests, quizzes or prepare to retake any past quizzes or tests.

It is recommended that you find a place to work free from distraction. Turn off your phone, or silence it and stay off social media while you are concentrating on your math work.

Attendance

You will need to login to Teams each weekday and sign in to class to be counted present.

On the main page in Teams there will be a Tab at the top that says “Attendance”. Click on this tab and complete this survey each school day (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday). You will need to complete this survey each day to be counted present for my class. If you complete this survey after I have already submitted attendance for the day, I will adjust the absence the following school day. For example, if you complete this at 7:53 pm, the next day when I look at the survey results again, and I will change your absence in PowerSchool to present. If you notice it has not been changed after two days, please send me an email and let me know
