
Dear CGUHSD Parents and Guardians:

I need to inform you that the district now has positive COVID-19 cases reported at both of our school campuses. District practice and protocol is to report directly to the Pinal County Health Department when we are notified of these cases and to follow their guidance with how to proceed. In all the current cases, we have worked directly with the teachers and staff who were in these students' classrooms. Yesterday, the district notified both the students and staff members who were in these classrooms and also sent a second notification from the Pinal County Health Department to those who were in close proximity of these students for more than 15 minutes while they were on campus of their potential exposure. Only those students and staff members who were potentially exposed have been notified. If you have not received notification from the district or your site principal, to the best of our knowledge, your child has not been potentially exposed. In the cases that were recently identified, the Pinal County Health Department also recommends that those students and/or staff members who were in close proximity to these students, quarantine for 14 days as a precaution, regardless of whether or not those individuals choose to get tested.

Even though our district has met all three benchmarks to operate in the hybrid model for several weeks now, with the number of cases going up in the state, it is critical that students are wearing their masks at all times and are practicing the safe social distancing guidelines.

We will continue to keep you updated should things change and will continue our due diligence to keep all students and staff safe during these challenging times.
