Dear Parents and Students,

In compliance with the social distancing guidelines resulting from the Covid-19 pandemic, Casa Grande Union High School District will be offering summer school in an online only format. Students in grades 9-12 will be receiving online instruction using the Edgenuity online Platform.

All summer school offerings will be credit recovery only, beginning May 26 – June 18. Because of the Memorial Day holiday, the first week of online classes will begin on Tuesday, May 26 - Friday, May 29. All remaining weeks of summer school will be Monday-Thursday, ending on June 18<sup>th</sup>. Since our courses are online students are encouraged to work on their course no less than 4 hours a day. Online office hours for teachers will be from 8:30 – 12:30. The cost of each course is \$50.00.

- Because all courses are being held in an online only format, students will not need to be transported to a school building.
- All course offerings are limited to the following:
  - Seniors – English, math, science, social studies
  - Sophomores & Juniors – English and math courses only
  - Freshmen – English courses only
- In order to receive credit for the course, students will need to complete all assignments and are expected to take a final exam.
- Registration and fees must be completed online (Check the school website for more information)

Please check with the school guidance counseling department to make sure your student is eligible for summer school. Students are being asked to keep their laptops if they are taking a summer school course.
