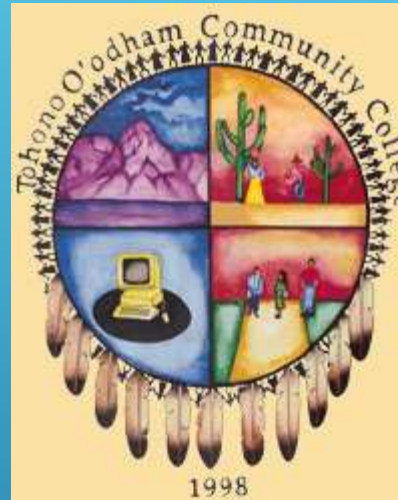


FY20-21 Title VI Indian Education Program

- FY20-21 Received \$86,622.00

 - Student fees for CTE, ACT & SAT testing, Advanced Placement testing, the PASS program etc...

Native American Parent Advisory Committee (PAC) SY20-21

- Required by the Office of Indian Education
- PAC are involved in the development and evaluation of educational projects with the intent of better serving Native American students.




Eligibility



- A parent/legal guardian or family member of a Native American student currently enrolled in one of the district high schools
- A representative of Native American tribes on Native American lands located within 50 miles of any CGUHSD school that the agency serves
- Teachers or counselors working for CGUHSD (paid with funding other than Title VI)
- No more than one (1) Native American student

Membership Continued:

- More than half of the membership must be parents/guardian or family members of Native American students currently served by CGUHSD.
 - PAC shall have a minimum of three (3) but not more than five (5) members this first year.
 - No individual family shall have more than one (1) seat on the PAC. No close relatives may sit on the PAC during the same school year.
- 

Duties of a PAC Member

- Attend maximum of three meetings a year
- Provide leadership and representation- feedback!
- Term is for the current school year (through June 30, 2021)



Nomination Process

- Nomination by survey!
 - Due to COVID will be done electronically
- Can nominate **yourself or someone else**
 - If nominating someone else get their permission
- Nomination survey goes out on 10/20/20 and must be returned no later than 10/26/20
- Voting Survey will then be created and sent out
