## Title VI Requirements

- An application is made annually- working on a 3 year program
- No carryover of funds permitted into the next year
- Grant period is July 1 to June 30 of each school year
- Grant focus is to assist in meeting the culturally related academic needs of Native American students.
- **Title VI funds must supplement and not supplant other Federal, State or Local funding that are providing services to Native American students.**

## **FY22-23 Title I Program (federal)**

### **\*Traditionally our primary educational assistance funding**

Support the following educational services:

- Achieve 3000 Reading Intervention Program (new)
- Alek Math Intervention Program (new)
- Before school, lunch-time and after school tutoring
- Credit recovery during Intercession Periods & Summer School
- Reading Intervention Teachers in Classroom
- Academic Excellence Assistants & IEC's in Core Content for Intervention Assistance

-Homeless (McKinney-Vento) support including school supplies, personal necessity needs (clothing/hygiene) and course fees

## FY 22-23 Targeted School Improvement (federal)

- Both school sites will have a Title I/School Improvement Coordinator
- Focus is how to better address the educational needs of targeted subpopulations
  - CGUHS English Language Learners & Native American Students
  - VGHS English Language Learners & Exceptional Student Services

## ESSER III- American Rescue Plan (federal)

- We received approximately \$6,901,274.77
- Funds will be used from July 1, 2021 through September 30, 2024
- Required to spend at least 20% to address learning loss due to COVID
  - Our minimum portion would be between \$1.2 to \$1.4 million
- All activities and interventions must be:
  - Evidence based
  - Address academic, social and emotional needs of students
  - Address the disproportionate impact of COVID on subgroup populations
    - Major ethnic/racial groups
    - Low-income students
    - Children with disabilities
    - English language learners
    - Migrant students
    - Homeless students
    - Youth in foster care
- Activities/Interventions include tutoring, credit recovery, summer learning, intercession period support etc...
