

Title VI Parent Advisory Committee Meeting

Meeting Minutes

October 27, 2021

Call To Order:

The regular meeting of the Title VI Parent Advisory Committee was called to order at 5:35 pm on October 27, 2021 on a Virtual Teams meeting by Yolonda Garcia (Chair).

Approval of Agenda:

Discussion Agenda Items:

1. Introduction new members of NAPAC – Term SY21-22 & SY22-23
2. 2020-2021 Grant Update – Review of expenditures for both the SY20-21 Title VI grant and SY21-22 Title VI grant. Talia Apkaw & Pam Pratt (parent members) suggested a more detailed listing of student fees covered/not covered in the SY20-21 Title VI budget sheet.
3. Review/Discussion of Native American Policies & Procedures (NAPP) – The committee reviewed each section of the Native American Policies and Procedures document and discussed its contents. Members indicated that they would like additional time to review the document before making recommendations and/or voting on acceptance for the year.
