<a href="#">10 Words or Less Scholarship</a>	-	11/30	\$500	Scholarship is open to students between the ages of 14-25 who will be attending school in the Fall of 2021. Applicant must share in 10 words or less why they deserve the scholarship
<a href="#">AED Superstore \$1,000 College Scholarship</a>	-	11/30	\$1,000	Scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors and currently enrolled college students. Applicant must submit an essay on a given topic related to sudden cardiac arrest (SCA)
<a href="#">Asian &amp; Pacific Islander American Scholars</a>	9/9	1/14	Up to \$80,000	Scholarship is open to students of Asian and/or Pacific Islander ethnicity who plan to attend an accredited US college or University for Fall 2021. Applicants must be US citizens or permanent resident of the US and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7. To remain eligible for the scholarship, you must submit your FAFSA by April 2021.
<a href="#">AXA Achievement Scholarship</a>	9/1	12/15	Up to \$25,000	Applicant must be a current high school senior who plans to enroll full-time at an accredited two-year or four-year college or university in the United States for the entire 2021-2022 academic year. Applicant must demonstrate ambition and self-drive as evidenced by outstanding achievement in school, community or work-related activities. APPLY EARLY – only the first 10,000 applications will be considered.
<a href="#">Chief Manuelito Scholarship for High School Students</a>	-	11/25	\$7,000	Scholarship is open to high achieving high school graduates and undergraduate Navajo students
<a href="#">Create Real Impact Contest</a>	-	11/12	Up to \$1,500	Contest is open to legal residents of the 50 United States and the District of Columbia between the ages of 14 and 22 years. Applicant must create an original work showcasing their idea for a solution or strategy to fix the very real problem of reckless and distracted driving.
<a href="#">Dell Scholars</a>	10/1	12/1	\$20000, a laptop with 4-year warranty, \$500 in Chegg credits annuay for four years	Scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors who have participated in an approved college readiness program (such as Upward Bound – see full list on website) in grades 11 and 12. Applicant must have earned a minimum GPA of 2.4 and demonstrate financial need. Students must be eligible to receive a pell grant and plan to enroll full time at an accredited higher education institution for Fall 2021
<a href="#">Dorrance Scholarship</a>	9/1	2/10	\$12,000	The Dorrance Scholarship is a phenomenal scholarship for seniors who plan to attend one of the three public Arizona Universities (NAU, UA, or ASU) in Fall 2021. Every year, 36 scholarships are awarded to incoming college freshmen. This scholarship provides \$12,000 and is renewable for each year. Dorrance Scholars also receive entrepreneurship experience, internship experience, a Dorrance advisor, cultural enrichment (study abroad/international travel), community outreach opportunities, tutoring & mentoring, and will participate in a 5-week Summer Bridge experience. Eligible applicants must be an Arizona seniors, first generation college student, 3.0 unweighted GPA, 1120 SAT or 22 ACT, demonstrate leadership and volunteer service.
<a href="#">Dr. Juan Andrade Scholarship for Young Hispanic Leaders</a>	-	11/30	Up to \$1,000	Scholarship is open to students enrolled or accepted for enrollment as a full-time student, in an accredited four-year or two-year institution in the U.S. or U.S. territories, and demonstrates a verifiable need for financial support. At least one parent must be of Hispanic ancestry. Non-U.S. citizens are eligible to apply (DACA or undocumented).

<a href="#">Dream Act Scholarship</a>	-	11/30	\$500	Scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors and current college students who are interested in making a difference in the lives of immigrants and other non-native individuals living in the United States. Applicant must submit an essay on a given topic related to current immigration conditions
<a href="#">Education Matters Scholarship</a>	-	11/30	\$5,000	Scholarship is open to students 13 years of age or older who are legal residents of the 50 United States or the District of Columbia and are currently enrolled (or will enroll no later than the fall of 2026) in an accredited post-secondary institution of higher education. Applicant will need to submit a short response to a given prompt.
<a href="#">Elk Most Valuable Student</a>	8/5	11/15	Up to \$100,000	Competition is open to high school seniors who are citizens of the United States.
<a href="#">Generation Google Scholarship For Current University Students</a>	-	12/4	\$10,000	Scholarship is open to currently enrolled undergraduate and graduate students who are pursuing a computer science or computer engineering degree, or a degree in a closely related technical field. Applicant must be a student from an underrepresented group in computer science (African-American, Hispanic, American Indian, or Filipino/Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander).
<a href="#">Griswold Home Care Scholarship</a>	-	11/30	\$1,000	Scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors with plans to be enrolled in a higher education program next year or current college students. Applicant must be currently providing or have provided support for an individual.
<a href="#">Hispanic Heritage Foundation</a>	-	12/6	Varies	This award honors Latino high school who excel in the classroom and community and for their excellence in various categories including Business & Finance, Entrepreneurship, Education, Healthcare & Science, Media & Entertainment, Sports and Technology. This scholarship is open to current graduating seniors with a 3.0 GPA, who will be enrolled in an accredited high education insititution for the 2021-2022 school year, be of hispanic heritage (including Spain, Brazil, Phillippines, be a US permanent resident, US citizen or qulify under DACA.
<a href="#">Innovation Scholarship Essay Contest</a>	March	12/1	\$1,000 to \$2,500	Scholarship is open to high school juniors and seniors, and students currently enrolled in a two-year or four-year college or university in the United States. Applicant must submit an creative entry in any format such as video, peom, infographic, essay, piece of art, or song addressing the following toping: "Share a community service activity or project you participated in that postively changed your community, contributed to your growth, and/or affected your plans for the future".

Applicant must submit a 750-1000 word essay on "how has social media helped advance the cause of civil rights in America?" as well as share the essay contest page on Facebook and twitter.
<a href="#">Lamber-Goodnow Injury Law Team College Scholarship</a>	-	12/1	\$1,000	Scholarships are open to students enrolled at an accredited high school, college, or university with a 2.8 GPA or higher. Applicant must submit an essay on how they are driven to innovate.

<a href="#">Molded Dimensions, LLC Scholarship</a>	-	11/30	\$500	Scholarship is open to U.S. citizens accepted to or currently attending a college or university in the United States and studying in a STEM field. Applicant must submit a personal essay.
<a href="#">National Space Club and Foundation Keynote Scholars Program</a>	-	12/1	\$10,000	Scholarship is open to high school seniors, college undergraduate students, and graduate students with plans to pursue a career in the science, technology, engineering, or math (STEM) fields. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen.

<a href="#">Reel Milk Moments Video Contest</a>	10/1	1/31	Up to \$8,000	Contest is open to legal residents of Arizona who are 17 years of age or older and are (or will be) enrolled in a post-secondary school (university, college, or community college) in the state of Arizona for the 2021 fall term with at least 12 credit hours. Student must create a "reel" Milk Moment video, lasting 30 seconds or less, featuring their favorite dairy product(s).
<a href="#">Regeneron Science Talent Search</a>	-	11/12	Up to \$250,000	Talent search is open to any student who is enrolled in and attending his or her last year of secondary school in the United States or its territories. Applicant must conduct independent science, math or engineering research.
<a href="#">Ron Brown Scholar Program</a>	August	1/9	\$10000/year for 4 years	Scholars program is open to African-American/Black high school seniors who excel academically and demonstrate a keen interest in public service, community engagement, business entrepreneurship and global citizenship.
<a href="#">Science Ambassador Scholarship</a>	-	12/14	Full-tuition	Scholarship is open to women seeking an undergraduate degree in science, engineering, or math. Applicant must be enrolled in fall of 2021. There is no citizenship requirement, but student must be or planning to attend a college in the U.S. Applicant must submit a three minute video explaining a topic in science they are passionate about.
<a href="#">Smithsonian.com Photo Contest</a>	-	11/30	Up to \$2,500	Contest is open to individuals worldwide who are at least 18 years of age. Contestant can submit photos in the categories of Natural World, Travel, People, The American Experience, Altered Images, or Mobile.
<a href="#">Staver Law Group Personal Injury Scholarship</a>	-	12/1	\$5,000	Scholarship is open to incoming and current college students with at least a 3.0 GPA and are U.S. citizens or permanent residents. Applicant must submit an essay on a given topic related to personal injury lawyers.

Brady Stop Hunger Scholarships</a>	10/5	12/5	\$5,000	Scholarship is open to students in kindergarten through graduate school (ages 5-25) who have demonstrated ongoing commitment to their community by performing unpaid volunteer services impacting hunger in the United States within the last 12 months.

Applicants must be a US citizen and be a graduating high school student. Applicants whose GPA places them in the top 5% of their class will not be considered.
