Alpine Recovery Lodge Bi-Annual Scholarship Essay Contest	-	11/1	\$1,000	Scholarship is open to high school seniors and current undergraduate and graduate students who are residents of Utah, Colorado, Idaho, Wyoming, New Mexico, Arizona, or Nevada. AmericanMuscle Automotive Scholarships	-	10/15	\$2,500	Scholarship is open to high school seniors and current college students who are pursuing an automotive degree or related field of study.
AmericanTrucks Student Scholarships	-	10/15	\$2,000	Scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors and students currently enrolled full-time in an accredited United States technical institute, secondary votech or tuition bearing apprenticeship program in he traditional building trades (e.g. carpentry, HVAC, electrical or related fields of study.
Asian & Pacific Islander American Scholars	9/9	1/14	Up to \$80,000	Scholarship is open to students of Asian and/or Pacific Islander ethnicity who plan to attend an accredited US college or University for Fall 2021. Applicants must be US citizens or permanent resident of the US and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7. To remain eligible for the scholarship, you must submit your FAFSA by April 2021.
AXA Achievement Scholarship	9/1	12/15	Up to \$25,000	Applicant must be a current high school senior who plans to enroll full-time at an accredited two-year or four-year college or university in the United States for the entire 2021-2022 academic year. Applicant must demonstrate ambition and self-drive as evidenced by outstanding achievement in school, community or work-related activities. APPLY EARLY – only the first 10,000 applications will be considered.
Chief Manuelito Scholarship for High School Students	-	11/25	\$7,000	Scholarship is open to high achieving high school graduates and undergraduate Navajo students
Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation	8/1	10/31	up to \$20,000	3.0 UW GPA; achievement -based scholarship awarded to students for their capacity to lead and serve, as well as their commitment to making a significant impact on their schools and communities
Create Real Impact Contest	-	11/12	Up to \$1,500	Contest is open to legal residents of the 50 United States and the District of Columbia between the ages of 14 and 22 years. Applicant must create an original work showcasing their idea for a solution or strategy to fix the very real problem of reckless and distracted driving.
Dorrance Scholarship	9/1	2/10	\$12,000	The Dorrance Scholarship is a phenomenal scholarship for seniors who plan to attend one of the three public Arizona Universities (NAU, UA, or ASU) in Fall 2021. Every year, 36 scholarships are awarded to incoming college freshmen. This scholarship provides \$12,000 and is renewable for each year. Dorrance Scholars also receive entrepreneurship experience, internship experience, a Dorrance advisor, cultural enrichment (study abroad/international travel), community outreach opportunities, tutoring & mentoring, and will participate in a 5-week Summer Bridge experience. Eligible applicants must be an Arizona seniors, first generation college student, 3.0 unweighted GPA, 1120 SAT or 22 ACT, demonstrate leadership and volunteer service.
Dr. Juan Andrade Scholarship for Young Hispanic Leaders	-	11/30	Up to \$1,000	Scholarship is open to students enrolled or accepted for enrollment as a full-time student, in an accredited four-year or two-year institution in the U.S. or U.S. territories, and demonstrates a verifiable need for financial support. At least one parent must be of Hispanic ancestry. Non-U.S. citizens are eligible to apply (DACA or undocumented).
Dream Act Scholarship	-	11/30	\$500	Scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors and current college students who are interested in making a difference in the lives of immigrants and other non-native individuals living in the United States. Applicant must submit an essay on a given topic related to current immigration conditions.
Education Matters Scholarship	-	11/30	\$5,000	Scholarship is open to students 13 years of age or older who are legal residents of the 50 United States or the District of Columbia and are currently enrolled (or will enroll no later than the fall of 2026) in an accredited post-secondary institution of higher education. Applicant will need to submit a short response to a given prompt.
Elk Most Valuable Student	8/5	11/15	Up to \$100,000	Competition is open to high school seniors who are citizens of the United States.
Golden Door Scholarships	-	10/25	Full tuition, room and board (4 years) at a Golden Door partner school	Scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors and recent high school graduates who are eligible for DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals) or TPS (Temporary Protected Status). Applicants from states where DACA students must pay out-of-state tuition at public universities and community colleges will be given strong preference.
Griswold Home Care Scholarship	-	11/30	\$1,000	Scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors with plans to be enrolled in a higher education program next year or current college students. Applicant must be currently providing or have provided support for an individual.

Hispanic Heritage Foundation	-	12/6	Varies	This award honors Latino high school who excel in the classroom and community and for their excellence in various categories including Business & Finance, Entrepreneurship, Education, Healthcare & Science, Media & Entertainment, Sports and Technology. This scholarship is open to current graduating seniors with a 3.0 GPA, who will be enrolled in an accredited high education insititution for the 2021-2022 school year, be of hispanic heritage (including Spain, Brazil, Phillippines, be a US permanent resident, US citizen or qualify under DACA.
Horatio Alger Scholarship	8/1	10/25	Up to \$22,000	Scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors. Applicant must demonstrate critical financial need, display integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity, and be involved in co-curricular and community service activities.
IEI Bi-Annual Scholarship Essay Contest	-	11/1	\$1,000	Scholarship is open to incoming and current undergraduate students in the United States and Canada. Applicant must submit an essay on one of three given topics related to HVAC, energy-efficient building, or building structure fires.
Jack Kent Cooke Foundation Scholarships	8/1	10/30	Up to \$40,000/year	Scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors who have at least at 3.5 GPA and at least 1200 on the SAT and/or 26 on the ACT. Scholars are selected based on exceptional academic ability and achievement, financial need, persistence, service to others, and leadership.
John F. Kennedy Profile in Courage Essay Contest	9/1	1/15	Up to \$10,000	Contest is open to United States high school students in grades nine through twelve. Applicant must submit an essay on a given topic related to an act of political courage.
Lifeway Scholarship	-	11/30	\$5,000	Scholarship is open to U.S. citizens accepted to or currently attending a college or university within the United States. Applicant must submit a personal essay about their future goals and how they aspire to help people lead healthier lives
Local Conservation Scholarship and Essay Contest	-	10/31	\$1,000	Scholarship is open to incoming and current college students who can demonstrate a commitment to environmental conservation using past and present volunteer, professional, and educational experiences. Applicant must submit a personal statement explaining their dedication to local conservation.
Molded Dimensions, LLC Scholarship	-	11/30	\$500	Scholarship is open to U.S. citizens accepted to or currently attending a college or university in the United States and studying in a STEM field. Applicant must submit a personal essay.
National Eagle Scout Association Scholarships	-	10/31	Varies	Scholarships are open to high school seniors through college juniors who are Eagle Scouts.
NCWIT Award for Aspirations in Computing (AiC)	-	11/5	Varies	Scholarship is open to U.S. high school and college women with an interest in computing and technology.
Prudential Spirit of Community Award	-	11/10	Up to \$5,000	Award is open to all young people in grades 5-12 who live in the 50 United States and Washington, D.C., and have conducted a volunteer service activity within the past year.
Reel Milk Moments Video Contest	10/1	1/31	Up to \$8,000	Contest is open to legal residents of Arizona who are 17 years of age or older and are (or will be) enrolled in a post-secondary school (university, college, or community college) in the state of Arizona for the 2021 fall term with at least 12 credit hours. Student must create a "reel" Milk Moment video, lasting 30 seconds or less, featuring their favorite dairy product(s).
Regeneron Science Talent Search	-	11/12	Up to \$250,000	Talent search is open to any student who is enrolled in and attending his or her last year of secondary school in the United States or its territories. Applicant must conduct independent science, math or engineering research.
Ron Brown Scholar Program	August	1/9	\$10000/year for 4 years	Scholars program is open to African-American/Black high school seniors who excel academically and demonstrate a keen interest in public service, community engagement, business entrepreneurship and global citizenship.
Smithsonian.com Photo Contest	-	11/30	Up to \$2,500	Contest is open to individuals worldwide who are at least 18 years of age. Contestant can submit photos in the categories of Natural World, Travel, People, The American Experience, Altered Images, or Mobile.
The Valley Foundation Scholarship	September	2/28	\$1,500 to \$4,000	This scholarship was created to provide financial assistance to Arizona students based on their participation in school activities, community involvement, employment and financial need rather than on their grades. Applicants must be a US citizen and be a graduating high school student. Applicants whose GPA places them in the top 5% of their class will not be considered.
Thomas J. Henry Leadership Scholarship Program	-	11/1	\$1,000	Scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors and current undergraduate and graduate students. Applicant must submit an essay on the importance of leadership.
VFW Voice of Democracy	July	10/31	Up to \$30,000	Program is open to students in grades 9-12 who are enrolled in a public, private or parochial high school or home study program in the United States and its territories. Applicant must submit a 3-5 minute audio-essay on this year's theme; Is This the Country the Founders Envisioned?
Walmart Associate Scholarship	-	11/30	Varies	Scholarship is open to students employed part-time or full-time with any division of Walmart for at least six consecutive months prior to the scholarship due date.
Young Writers Awards	-	11/1	Up to \$500	Students in the 10th, 11th, and 12th grades can enter in one of the following categories: poetry (a group of three poems), fiction (a short story or one-act play), or nonfiction (a personal or academic essay. All entries must be original work and sponsored by a high school teacher).
